



All athletes who use a MASH measurement must be measured during your WPA approved competition and provide verification of measurement. It is the athlete's responsibility that they are measured at every event. The official measuring height can be a call tent clerk, technical delegate, meet director or classifier. The measurement can be taken using a stadiometer or a tape measure.

The form below must be filled out and signed by the person completing the measurements and must be an official, call room clerk, classifier or U.S. T& Field coach or staff member.
